HIGHLAND DANCING EVENTS

Dancing has always been part of Highland Games. Whilst in earlier times it was an all male preserve, nowadays more females than males take part. True Highland dances consist of only three : **the Highland Fling** – the oldest and is said to mimic Red Deer on the hill, **the Sword Dance** which recaptures the post battle celebrations when the highlander dances over his sword and that of his vanquished opponent and **the Seann Triubhas** which is a celebratory dance for the re-introduction of the kilt after its prescription following Culloden in 1745 in place of “trews” (triubhas).
